All locomotives received for general overhaul and digital conversion are completely stripped, cleaned and reassembled with fresh lubrication, traction tires and brushes. Pick-up shoes are replaced as necessary. This is the only way to ensure factory quality performance especially when installing digital decoders. Everything must be 100% mechanically for absolute peak performance. Labor for most overhauls and digital conversions is \$55.00. Complex locomotives, locomotives with extreme wear and conversions with telex, multiple motors or those which require additional programming may be higher and labor for these is billed based on the actual work time @ \$55.00/hr billed in 1/10 hour increments.

An **mfX** decoder preloads locomotive address and function information into the Märklin Central Station and Mobile Station automatically when the locomotive is placed on the track for the first time. This technology does not work the same with the Märklin 6021. However, an mfx equipped locomotive can still be run with the 6021 when using its two-digit Motorola address.
